<p>TUCKSHOP – The Tuckshop is managed by the P&C’s Convenor, Mrs Anne Takats. The Tuckshop operates 5 days per week with the help of parent volunteers, who may elect to work fortnightly, monthly, twice per term or once per term. Unfortunately children are unable to accompany parents on roster. Roster forms were sent to all families a week prior to this survey going out. However, if you require a form, please indicate opposite.</p>	<p>Tuckshop roster: Parents can volunteer to work at the Tuckshop by adding their names to the roster. <p>UNIFORM SHOP – The Uniform Shop is managed by the P&C’s Convenor, Mrs Catherine Gafenesch, who is assisted by volunteers. The shop is located under Boomerang Wing (near Moggill Rd) and operates on Monday and Thursday mornings (8.15am – 9.15am), with workers staying on another 15 minutes. When these days fall on a public holiday or pupil free day the Uniform Shop opens the following day. The shop also opens in Jan/Feb for two days (usually Fri, Sat) immediately prior to the first day of the school year, for the convenience of new families. Volunteers (unaccompanied by children please) are required at busy times only, such as Term 1 (first fortnight), Terms 2-4 (first week), Orientation Days and the two days prior to new school year.</p>	<p>Uniform Shop roster: Parents can volunteer to work at the Uniform Shop by phoning Mrs Catherine Gafenesch (ph: 33787071) to add their names to the roster to work from time to time for no more than two (2) hours (usually 1 hour 15 mins).</p>
<p>COMMUNITY EDUCATION – This service is managed by Mrs Catherine Gafenesch. Regular courses include Pilates, Yoga, Watercolours, Golf, Tennis (Learn to play and social), Aqua Aerobics, Fitness Classes, Latin & Ballroom Dancing, languages (French, Italian, Japanese & Spanish), Drawing and Indian Vegetarian Cooking.</p>	<p>Course suggestions: Please let us know if you would like to work as a paid teacher or if you have any suggestions for courses not currently offered.</p>
<p>Courses are run each term after the Course Brochure is mailed out within the school and broader community. Enrolment details appear on the brochure. <p>A team of volunteer Booking Clerks is needed to register students. The job entails being available to take bookings by phone for one or two courses between 6pm and 9pm over a three week period prior to the start of each Term. The last week of the booking period is usually the first week of the Term.</p>	<p>Bookings clerks: Parents can volunteer to be rostered as a Bookings Clerk by contacting Catherine Gafenesch.</p>
<p>The course brochure is sent out to around 28,000 homes in the western suburbs each Term. <p>SWIMMING POOL – The school’s successful swimming club (The Otters) operates, as a sub-committee of the P & C Association, every Friday night (6:30pm - 8:30pm) during the summer season (September - April). Other activities include swimming classes (conducted by the club-appointed coaches, Mr Robert Cusack and Mr Simon Cusack) and competition carnivals.
